[Music] hi everyone and here so today we're going to talk about opinion persuasive and argumentative essay (this type of paper you can get from [academic proofreading service uk](#)) we're going to take a look at their differences the opinion persuasive and argumentative writing differs in different areas what are their differences they differ in purpose general technique key words and transitions point of view attitude perspectives presented starting point and support let's take a look at their differences one by one purpose in writing the opinion essay it should take a stand on topic and supports opinions and facts definitions and details in persuasive essay it focuses on convincing the reader to agree with the writer the writer uses logic and facts to persuade the reader an argumentative essay is used to support claims in an analysis of a topic the writer uses facts evidence and reasons to develop claims and opposing claims general technique in writing the opinion essay the writer states what he thinks and why he thinks it in persuasive essay opinions are blended with facts all in an attempt to convince the reader that the writer is right an argumentative essay relevant reasons and credible data are blended to demonstrate the writer's argument as valid there are different keywords and transitions that are used in writing the essays below are the common transition signals that are used for opinion essay you can use the following also because therefore since for example for instance in order to in addition consequently finally in conclusion for persuasive essay first next last additionally not only this but also this thus and other words for argumentative essay however but in contrast while on the other hand nevertheless as a result accordingly in conclusion point of view for opinion essay the first person for example I is always used because the writer is predominantly concerned with stating his opinion in persuasive essay it is common to use the first person and second person for example you since the writer is communicating directly to a person or organization an argumentative essay this more formal writing addresses the multiple sides of an issue using the more objective third person point of view because of no specific audience in mind attitude in opinion essay opinion writers are excited about their own ideas and eager to share them with whomever will listen in persuasive essay persuasive writers go after their readers' hearts they consider the emotional strategy that will work best on their audience for example manipulation motivation inspiration and others persuasive writing is personal passionate and emotional as for argumentative writing argumentative writers maintain a tone of fairness and reasonableness their attitude is respectful tactful and formal perspectives presented in opinion so remember that the opinion has a single-minded cold tell the reader what you think which means it is just one-sided for persuasive essay persuasion has a single-minded cold get what the writer wants it is based on the writer's personal conviction that his way of thinking is the best consequently the writer's viewpoint is typically the only one presented which

means it is lopsided in argumentative writing a technologist opposing views within a pro/con piece which means it is balanced this demonstrates the writer as a fair-minded person and gives him the opportunity to counter these perspectives with more logic reasoning and proof starting a point there are three steps in starting a point in each of the essays for opinion essay you should pick a topic and then decide what they think and write about it for persuasive essay you have to pick a topic of interest for example asking the question what do you want and then after that you choose a side fight work and then start writing for argumentative writing you first have to conduct initial research on a debatable topic aligned with the strongest fight and continue gathering facts and research support remember that the writing an opinion essay opinion pieces rely solely on opinions and feelings in persuasive essay persuasive thesis rely almost solely on opinions and feelings the writer uses his own fashion and her place of readers emotions to get what he wants the reader agrees who the writer because of strong emotional appeals in writing the argumentative essay arguments rely on logical reasons but are all substantiated by facts data experts and evidence the reader agrees with a writer because of the strong logical Appeals [Music] [Music] if you have answer assume you are correct conveniently says right you're like most importantly personally whereas persuasive writing their life old-fashioned and usage of emotions persuade the reader question number two your own personal opinion matters when you are writing an argumentative essay is it true or false [Music] if your answer is false you are correct your own personal opinion matters when you are writing an opinion and persuasive essay but not in an argumentative essay writing an argumentative essay is more challenging because the writer has to support his writing with facts evidence data are expert coats true or false if your answer is true yes you are correct as compared to persuasive and opinion essays your feelings or opinion should not be expressed when you write an argumentative essay your writing should be backed up with facts evidence data or expert comas so there you have it just remember your personal opinion and feelings are the main focus in writing an opinion essay express your opinion feelings passion and play up the readers emotions to persuade your readers when writing a persuasive essay finally when you're writing an argument to give essay which is the most challenging part you have to back or support your writing by facts evidence data or expert clothes so I hope that you have understood the differences of these essays see you [Music]
